

Commissioners Court convened in regular session Saturday, Nov. 14, 1925, at its regular meeting place in the Court House, the following members of the Court being present to-wit:

and among other transactions the following order was passed:

That since the State Highway Commissioner of Texas of date Sept. 22, 1925, contracted and agreed with the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas to grant to the County for the use of and to pay for the graveling of three miles of Section B, Highway No. 8, Job 202-E in Sabine County, the sum of \$14,000 to be paid on March 1, 1926, and Sabine County being desirous of having the said three miles graveled before the said \$14,000.00 is available for payment to it, the Commissioners Court of the said Sabine County, J. T. Foely and R. O. Travis voting in favor of and C. W. Fuller voting against agreed to pay 8% interest per annum on the scrip or warrants to be issued against section B, Highway No. 8, Job 202-E, in payment of work, etc., done in said graveling, on said Highway until the Highway Commission makes the payment of the \$14,000.00 on or about March 1st, 1926.

Ordered by the Court to award the Contract of getting the Huffman Bridge out of Creek on Patroon to W. E. Greer for \$67.54.

Ordered by the Court to award the Contract of getting the Iro Bridge on Patroon creek out of the creek and take same apart and straighten each and every piece so it will fit to replace an creek same awarded to Neal & Reeves for \$350.00.

Ordered by the Court to award the Contract of rebuilding what is known as Huffman Bridge on Patroon creek and also the Russell Bridge to J. E. Minton, Huffman Bridge for \$172.50, Russell Bridge \$279.90.

Ordered by the Court of award the building of the bridge known as Hogan Bridge on Patroon creek to W. T. Horn, rebuilding creek bridge building bridge on slough and getting out piling and building same complete for \$349.00.
