On this the 11th day of Jan. 1926, the Hon. Commissioners Court convene in regular session at the regular meeting place thereof, with the following officers present to wit:

W.H. Davidson, County Judge, C.W. Fuller Comm. Pre. #1, W.J. McDaniel, Comm. Pre. #2, J.T. Fosly, Comm. Pre. #3, and R.C. Travis, Comm. Pre. #4, J.H. Ener, Clerk, and S.H. Hall, Sheriff.

Ordered by the Court to allow J.W. Arnold, \$15.00 as County aid.

Ordered by the Court to allow M.E. Martin, \$102.00, for expenses for carrying his and Mr Boyd's children to the Pasteur Institute, at Austin, Texas, also ordered that T.C. Davidson, be allowed the sum of \$79.70, for the expense of his child to the same institute.

Ordered by the Court to accept the resignation of J.S. Howard, as Justice Peace Pre. # 6, Bronson, Texas.

Ordered by the Court to appoint I.N. Courtney, Justice Peace Pre. # 6, Bronson, Texas.

Ordered by the Court to raise the Ferryman's salary at Pendleton, from \$85.00 to \$100.00.

Ordered by the Court that J.P. Davidson, be awarded the Contract of painting the two pump houses, and that he furnish every thing for the sum of \$25.00.

On motion of C.W. Fuller and Second by W.J. McDaniel to pay the Telephone bills charged to the Sheriff and Districts Clerk's office, C.W. Fuller, and W.J. McDaniel voted aye, J.T. Fosly, voted Nay.

Ordered that all County Officers when in need of Stationery, furniture and fixtures and etc. for their offices, Court house, and Jail, shall before purchasing same present an itemized list of the articles needed and be approved by the Court.

Ordered by the Court that the Stationery Houses, or any person or firms, receiving orders from County officials for office supplies or supplies for the Court house or Jail, shall have said order made out itemizing same and giving prices and present same to the Commissioners Court for their approval before the sale is consummated.

Ordered by the Court to allow J.H. Minton, \$10.00 for attorney fee in the case No. 2032 and # 2033, County Court.

Order by the Court that the 1925 valuation of the Town Site at Bronson, Texas, owned by the Kirby Lumber Company be reduced from \$33,110.00, as shown by the Assessor's 1925, rolls to \$27,500.000, per the agreement between J. T. Foely, Commissioner Precinct No. 3, Sabine County, and H. M. Seaman, Agent of the Kirby Lumber Company during the month of June 1925, and which agreement is approved by the entire court.

That the 96 acres of the Martin White Survey, Abstract 61, owned by Kirby Lumber Company, Southwestern Settlement & Development Company, et al be taken off the unrendered rolls for 1925, which carry thereon an approximate value of \$750.00 and placed on the supplemental rolls at a value of \$555.00.
