

Be it remembered that on the 28th day of January 1926 a call session of the Commissioner's Court of Sabine County, Texas, was held, W.H. Davidson, County Judge, C.W. Fuller, Commissioner Pre. #1, W.J. McDaniel, Comm. Pre. #2, J.T. Foley, Comm. Pre. #3, and H.C. Travis, Comm. Pre. #4, Ordered by the Court that the Tax Collector of Sabine County, is hereby authorized to accept payment and issue receipt for State and County taxes assessed on the rolls for the year 1925, without the payment of special road district bond taxes.

It is further ordered that where tax payers do not pay the special road district bond taxes, he shall write across the face of the receipt in red ink "Received without prejudice of Court's right to collect Road District Tax unpaid."

It is further ordered that the County Treasurer of Sabine County is hereby authorized to defer the payment of Special Road District Bonds and the accrued interest thereon waiting result of suit invalidating said bonds.

It is ordered that W.E. Carlton be reimbursed in the sum of \$11.75, which amount is an excess in taxes paid in by W.E. Carlton for the years 1923 and 1924, the County Clerk

is hereby authorized to issue warrant against Road & Bridge Fund in payment of same.
