Ordered by the Court that L.G. Thomas, W.J. McNaughten and P.H. McGowan, be and is hereby placed in said Geneva Stock Law District, and said District Field notes will read as follows:

Beginning on the southern boundary of the Geneva Stock Law District at the Southeast corner of the O.K. Tilley tract of land.

Thence easterly with the north line of the L.G. Thomas 11 acre tract to its N. E. Cor. Thence southerly with the east line of said 11 acres to another corner thereof. Thence northeasterly with N. line of the Finley 71 acres to its N.E. cor. Thence Easterly with the north lines of said L.G. Thomas land to his extreme N.E. cor. Thence Southerly with

the east lines of said L.G. Thomas land to his S.E. cor. also W.J. McNaughten's N.W. Cor.

Thence easterly southerly westerly, and northerly with the lines of W.J. McNaughten's land of the Phil. Boyett old place, to the southerly boundary of the L.G. Thomas 71 acre tract or Finley 71 acre tract.

Thence Westerly with south line said 71 acres to Logansport and Hemphill road.

Thence with said road southerly with the east line of a tract of 17 acres of land now owned by L.G. Thomas, and purchased by him from W.H. Thomas, to its S.E. cor.

Thence Westerly with south line said 17 acre tract to the southwest corner thereof, same being E. line P.H. McGown land. Thence southerly, with east line P.H. McGown land, to his S.E. cor. Thence Westerly with with the south lines of P.H. McGown's land to his S.W. cor. Thence northerly with the west lines of P.H. McGown's land at the S.W. cor. of the O.K. Tilley land and on the southern boundary line of said Geneva Stock Law District. Thence with the southern boundaries of said Geneva Stock Law District easterly, etc., to the place of beginning.

Now comes W.J. McNaughten, a resident citizen and a freeholder of Sabine County, Texas, and prays the Court to permit him to petition into the Milam Stock Law District, his land hereinafter described now being adjoining the present boundaries of said stock law district and described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning in Sabine County, Texas, on the southwestern boundary of said Milam Stock Law District at the N.W. cor. of the said W.J. McNaughten's land and the N.E. cor. of W.W. Boyett's land. Thence Southerly with the west line of said McNaughten's land to his S.W. Cor. Thence Easterly with the south line of said McNaughten's land to his S.E. cor. Thence Northerly with his east line to his N.E. cor. to the said South Western line of said Milam Stock Law District. Thence Westerly with the Southwestern line of said stock law district to the place of beginning.

Premises considered, petitioner prays that this Honorable Court enter its order permitting him to be placed within the boundaries of said Milam Stock Law District.

The Petition of the Magnolia Pipe Line, Co., asking the Court for permission to lay a pipe line through the County was granted.

It is hereby ordered by the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas, that Magnolia Pipe Line Company, its successors and assigns, is hereby granted the right to construct, operate and maintain a pipe line or pipe lines for the transportation of oil, gas, or water, over and along any and all the public roads of Sabine County, Texas; also the right to erect and maintain along and upon the said roads a line of poles with telephone and telegraph wires thereon. The said lines are to be so constructed as not to interfere with public travel in any way or to damage the public highway. It is distinctly understood and agreed that the said Magnolia Pipe Line Company, its successors and assigns, in the construction of the aforesaid lines shall at all times be subject to and conform to the orders of the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas.

Ordered by the Court that W.A. Byrd, and his successors, have the right to place post or wire in the town of Brookeland for the purpose of lights.

The petition of W.A. Byrd praying for the right to erect poles, upon which to construct a system of electric light wires, to maintain the same and operate a system of

electric lights over, along and under the public roads and highways throughout the village of Brookeland, Sabine County, Texas, coming on to be heard, and the court having considered the same;

It is therefore ordered by the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas, that W.A. Byrd, his heirs, successors and assigns, is hereby granted the right to erect any and all poles and to place thereon such wires and/or other equipment and appliances necessary and incident to the construction of and the operating of an electric light plant and system of electric light wires and other necessary appliances, and the right to construct, operate and maintain said poles and lines, over along and under the public roads and highways throughout the village of Brookeland, Sabine County, Texas, the said poles to be so erected and said wires and appliances so constructed, operated and maintained as not to interfere with public travel and safety not to in any manner damage the said public roads and highways. It is further distinctly understood and agreed and here so ordered, that the said W.A. Byrd, heirs, successors and assigns, in the construction of the above named electric light system and in the maintaining, operating and enjoying of the above named privileges shall at all times be subject to and conform to the orders of the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas.
