

On this the 8th day of March A.D. 1926, the Hon. Commissioners Court, convene in Regular session with all officers present to wit;-

W.H. Davidson, County Judge, C.W. Fuller, Comm. Pre. #1, W.J. McDaniel, Comm. Pre. #2, J.T. Foely, Comm. Pre. #3, and R.C. Travis, Comm. Pre. #4,

Ordered by the Court to have driveway post placed at the street crossings at each corner of the public square, and one placed at the Highway corner at or near the Halbert Filling station.

Driveway post must be made of concrete, well reinforced, and to be placed four feet in the ground and five feet above the ground, and being 12 in. square up to the top of the earth and to taper from 12x12 at the ground to 6x6 at the top.

Ordered by the Court to allow Reeves & Neal \$1100.00 for the rebuilding of the iron bridge on Patroon creek.

A petition signed by W.F. Rodgers and 20 other citizens praying the court to order an election to determine whether or not hogs, sheep and goats should run at large or not in the following territory to wit:-

Beginning at the most South west corner of C.M. Jordans tract, thence South to Sabine and Jasper County County line, thence Easterly along County line to a point on the Jas. McKim S. line, thence N.E. with McKim ~~xxxxxxx~~ league line to the N.E. corner of Jas. McKim League, thence N.W. with the North line of Jas. McKim to the N.E. corner of the Jno. Brandon 500 acre tract, thence W. along line of said 500 acre to its S.E. corner, thence N. 48 W. along S. line of 500 acre to Devils Ford Creek.

thence down said creek to where the said Jas. McKim S. league line crosses said creek.

Thence on a direct line to C.M. Jordans N.W. corner.

Thence along C.M. Jordans W. line to the place of beginning.

Ordered by the Court that said petition be granted and an election be ordered.

A petition signed by R.E. Boyett, and 38 other citizens asking the court to make the following change in the public road that the Rual route now travels to wit:-

Change the road through Pologocho creek bottom near the old Sneed mill place crossing the waste way about fifty yards below the old bridge place, and across the main old run about fifty yards above the old bridge place intersecting old road near the foot of the hill.

Ordered by the Court to Grant said petition as called for.

TO THE HONORABLE COMMISSIONER'S COURT?

Hemphill, Sabine County, Texas,

Gentlemen:

Now comes W.W. Boyett and Mrs. Frances Welch, resident citizens of Sabine County, Texas, and would respectfully show to the Court the following, to-wit:

1.

That your petitioner reside and own land in Sabine County, Texas, adjoining the present boundaries of the Milam Stock Law District.

2.

That it would be advantageous to your petitioners to be permitted to petition into said Milam Stock Law District.

3.

That a change made in the present boundaries of said Milam Stock Law District to read as follows would include your petitioners:.

Beginning in Sabine County, Texas, on the south line of said Milam Stock Law District, at the northwest corner of the land of Mrs. Frances Welch.

Thence southerly with the west line of the said Mrs. Frances Welch land to its southwest corner.

Thence easterly with the south line of said Welch land to its southeast corner, on the west line of the W.W. Boyett land.

Thence southerly with the west line of said Boyett land, to its southwest corner.

Thence southeasterly with the south line of said Boyett land to its southeast corner on the public road leading from Patsey Conn's residence to the residence of Ned Smith.

Thence easterly with the south line of said W.W. Boyett land to its extreme southeast corner, on a road leading from the residence of W.W. Boyett to the residence of Mrs. Frances Welch.

Thence northly with said road same being east line of the W.W. Boyett land, to its northeast corner of the southern boundary of the said Milam Stock Law District.

Thence westerly with said Milam Stock Law District's south line to the place of beginning.

Wherefore, petitioners prays the court to grant the above described changes in said Milam Stock Law District.
