

On this the 12th day of April A.D. 1926, The Honorable Commissioner's Court convened in regular session with all officers present, to-wit;

W.H. Davidson, County Judge, C.W. Fuller, Commissioner Precinct No. 1, W.J. McDaniel, Comm. Pre. # 2, J.T. Foely, Comm. Pre. No. 3, and R.C. Travis, Comm. Pre # 4, S.H. Hall, Sheriff, and J.H. Ener, Clerk.

A petition signed by L.W. McLenore and 16 other property tax paying voters, praying the Court to not make any change in the public road leading from Mrs. Y.E. Buckleys place to Pologoch Creek, which road the Rural Mail Rout now travels, and we further pray your Hon. body to rebuild the bridge on said rout on said Pologoch Creek at the old bridge place.

Ordered by the Court that said petition be granted.

A petition signed by Roy Buckley and 17 other citizens, praying the Court to lay out and establish a public road same to be a second class road Beginning at the Jim Fuller place on the Milan and Memphis Highway near Soragus Creek and extend by Will Dorseys and Bob Spight's places and intersecting the Milan Rural Mail Rout road in front of Roy Buckley's place Thence by Ed Dorsey's and Mrs Y.E. Buckley's places, thence from Mrs Y.E. Buckley's place westerly to the Right Coler league line, thence N. to the N.E. corner of Mrs. Dora Dickerson's place thence with following settlement road by H.C. Carltons, L.L. Buckhalter's, and G.A. Boyd's home place intersecting the public road leading from Geneva, by the way of W.M. Griffin's place and intersecting the Memphis and San Augustine public road at or near Mrs. Patsey's Comm. place.

and also to discontinue the part of the Milan and Rebo public road from Mrs. Y.E. Buckleys place to Pologoch Creek.

Ordered by the Court that said petition be granted with the exception of the part calling for the discontinuing the part of the other road. The public road is granted as asked for in the petition, but the other part of said petition is hereby refused.

Ordered by the court that the resignation of S.B. Glawson as Constable of Prec. No. 1 be accepted.

Ordered by the Court that A.F. Vickers be appointed Constable of Precinct No. 1.

Ordered by the court to allow the following names persons County aid, Mrs. Mollie Lakey, \$15.00, Mr Robert Williams, \$10.00, and Mr Benight, \$10.00.

Ordered and directed by the Commissioners Court that the Sabine Citizens Telephone

Company, its manager W.A.King, and the Temple Lumber Company, is hereby ordered and directed to move all telephone and light poles or post out of the streets, said poles or post to be moved back to the out edge of all streets, so no post will be on the inside of the streets.

The County Treasurer is ordered and directed by the Commissioners Court to take up all warrants against the Road and Bridge, and General County Funds to the amount of money now on hand in said funds, same to be done at once.

Ordered by the Court that V.E.Vickers be and is hereby recommended to the Live Stock Sanitarium Commissioner of Texas, to be appointed live stock inspector for Sabine County, Texas,.

On this the 13th day of April, A.D. 1926, the Commissioner's Court of Sabine County, Texas, convened at Hemphill, all of the members of said court, to-wit, W.H. Davidson, County Judge, C.W. Fuller, Commissioner of Precinct No. 1, W.J. McDaniel, Commissioner of Precinct No. 2, J.T. Foely, Commissioner of Precinct No. 3, and H.C. Travis, Commissioner of Precinct No. 4, being present and passed the following order:

Whereas, it has been made known to the Commissioners Court that 318 acres of the A.W. Canfield Survey of land, Abstract No. 3, was assessed to unknown owners on the unrendered Tax Rolls of Sabine County, for the year 1925, at a valuation of \$20.00 per acre, and it being further made known to the Court that such valuation is excessive and unreasonable and that \$10.00 per acre is a fair and reasonable valuation on said land.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that the valuation on said 318 acres be and is hereby reduced to \$10.00 per acre and the Tax Collector of this County is hereby ordered and instructed to accept payment on said land of the taxed due thereon for said year 1925, at a valuation of \$10.00 per acre, the following members of the Commissioner's Court voted in favor of the reduction, to-wit:
