
Be it remembered that on the 15th day of May 1926, a regular session of the Commissioners' Court of Sabine County, Texas, was held present, Hon. W.H. Davidson, County Judge, C.W. Fuller, Commissioner Precinct No. 1, W.J. McDaniel, Commissioner Precinct No. 2, J.T. Foely, Commissioner Precinct No. 3, and R.C. Travis, Commissioner Precinct, No. 4, when the following order was passed.

It is ordered that the Tax Collector of Sabine County, is hereby authorized to accept payment and issue receipt for the State and County Delinquent Taxes assessed on the tax rolls for the year 1922 to 1925 inclusive, without the payment of Special Road District Bond Taxes. It is further ordered that where tax payers do not pay the Special Road Bond Taxes, he shall write ^{across} the face of the receipt in red ink "Received without prejudice of Court's right to collect Road District Tax unpaid."

A petition was presented to the Court asking the court to grant the following change in the Yellowpine, and Fairdale Public road as follows to-wit:

Beginning on said road where the Temple Lumber Co. main line tram road crosses said road near N.E. McDaniel's place running in a Northeastern direction and intersecting the graded road that leads from N.A. Edgar's place to Oak Hill Church and then with said graded road back to the said Yellowpine and Fairdale road.

N.E. McDaniel, Ross McDaniel, S.T. Mason, E.S. McDaniel, V.O. Low, A.J. Rice, J.L. Bramblett and H.J. Low.

Ordered by the Court that said change be and is hereby granted.

Ordered by the Court that the Public Improvement Funds that are in the Treasurer for the year 1926 be divided as follows;

C.W. Fuller, \$1409.86, W.J. McDaniel, \$259.42, J.T. Foely, \$1213.25, R.C. Travis, \$1164.03.

Court adjourned until May 24th 1926.

Court Convened with all officers present and passed the following orders.

Ordered by the Court that Warrant No. 3465 issued on the 29th day of January 1926, in favor of George & Kerr, against Project 202-E, 327-B, be canceled, and the Clerk is ordered to issue another warrant for the same amount and to the same party out of the same fund, to take the place of the above warrant, as same is reported lost.

Ordered by the Court that H.D. Beckley, be and is hereby appointed Constable, Justice Precinct No. 1.
