Burt & Co. in payment for services and expenses in assembling and refunding indebtedness and for interest, \$3500.00; \$18,500.00, aggregating the sum of \$18,500.00.

We do further certify that we have this day canceled said warrants.

WE DO FURTHER CERTIFY that in lieu of the foregoing warrants against the general Fund of said County, we have delivered to the said Security Trust Company, Austin, Texas, SABINE COUNTY FUNDING WARRANTS, numbers 1 to 19 inclusive, aggregating \$18,500.00 of an issue of eighty-four warrants, of the denomination of \$1,000 each, except No. 1 which is of the denomination of \$500.00, aggregating \$83,500.00, dated September 1, 1926, bearing interest at the rate of six per cent per annum; which said Funding Warrants were duly and legally issued in pursuance of an order passed by the Commissioner's Court of Sabine County, Texas, on the 11th day of October 1926, which is recorded in Book M, pages 400 et seq. of the minutes of said Court.
