On this the 31st. day of December, A.D., 1926, the Commissioner's Court met in regular meeting place in the Court House in Hemphill, Texas, all members of the Court, To-wit:

being present, and transacted the following business:

All accounts per account ledger were approved and allowed.

Ordered that the personal property valuation of C.H. Young of Bronson, Texas, for the year 1926, be reduced from \$5210 as shown on assessor's rolls for the year 1926, to \$1500.00, the assessment of said property at said value being an error in the assessment.

Ordered that the valuation of the W.R. Pickering Lumber Co. on 118 $\frac{1}{2}$  Acres on the S.P. Tatom Headright be reduced from \$6010.00 to \$1180.00, and 956 acres on the Jas. Tippet be reduced from \$18450.00 to \$8450.00. The assessment of said property at said value being an error in the assessor.

Ordered that 100 acres of the Moses Hill Headright which is shown on the un-rendered roll be assessed by the Collector against the T.J. McLanahan Estate, and valued at \$485.00, this being an error in the Assessor in not showing property on the 1926 rolls.

Ordered that the Mose. Stock of A.P. Ener for the year 1926 be reduced from \$4,000.00 to \$3,000.00. This stock was raised by the Board of Equalization, but no notice given Ener of the raise.

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County Treasurer ordered and directed, to cancel General Funding Issue of \$15,000 issued February 1st, 1926, and registered March 13th, 1926, as shown by the Treasurer's Records. This Issue was contracted to Garrett & Company, Dallas, Texas, but turned down by them after the warrants were issued.

The First National Bank, (County Depository) is ordered and directed to deliver to the County Treasurer for cancellation the General Funding Issue, \$15,000.00 of February 1st, 1926, which is now in their possession.
