

On this the 1st day of January, 1927, the honorable Commissioners Court convened in Special Session, with all members thereof present, to-wit:

R. H. Dent, County Judge,

E. J. McGowen, Commissioner Precinct No. 1.

J. A. Hyden, Commissioner Precinct No. 2.

J. D. Edgar, Commissioner Precinct No. 3.

R. C. Travis, Commissioner Precinct No. 4.

1st. Ordered by the Court that the salaries of the County Officers be paid at the end of each month, by the County Clerk.

2nd. Ordered by the Court that each Officer present his stationary bill to the Court for approval before placing his order for same.

3rd. Ordered by the Court that each officer pay for his own wood, except wood that is used by the Court House while Court is in session, and wood that is used by prisoners while in jail. Said wood to be placed in County Jail and locked up.

4th. Ordered by the Court that the services of W.D. Powell be continued, as Janitor, for the ensuing year, and that his salary be \$1.50 per day each week day, and that he be allowed \$1.00 each week for cleaning up the jail.

5th. Ordered by the Court that the account of the Sabine County reporter, excepting \$5.50 which is to be paid by the County Judge. ~~which is to be paid by the County Judge~~

6th. Ordered by the Court that the services of the present County Agent be continued for the ensuing year, *at the same salary of 1000 Annually*.

7th. Ordered by the Court that the application of Mr. Ellison for aid be referred to the next Regular Meeting of the Court.
