Mr. Morrison having been duly appointed Justice of the Peace, Precinct No. 3 at a previous meeting of the court namely, June 27, 1927.

Dave Byrd, who was appointed Constable of Precinct No. 3 on June 27, 1927, and who desired not to serve, the court hereby recinds it's act of the appointment of Mr. Byrd and appoints D. L. Stoker to the said office of Constable of Precinct No. 3 and his bond with J. J. Williams, J. L. Bell and E. L. Dean as surties is hereby approved, said bond having been made subject to his appointment and it's approval by the Court.
