

Be it remembered that on this the second Monday in July, A. D. 1927, the same being the 11th day of July, A. D. 1927, there was begun and holden in the town of Hemphill, County of Sabine, State of Texas, at the court house thereof, a Regular Term of the Honorable Commissioners' Court, in and for Sabine County, Texas, with the Honorable R. H. Dent County Judge, in and for Sabine County, Texas, present and presiding, all members being present to-wit:

The Court having been duly opened, by proclamation of the Sheriff, the following orders were passed: That R. Y. Mitchel be appointed road overseer, on the road leading from Fairmount to Fairdale. ^{the 10,000 being removed} That R. L. Mettox be granted the franchise to construct and operate an electric light plant in the town of Bronson, Sabine County, Texas, and that he be permitted to erect poles upon which to construct a system of electric light wires to be used in connection with said business, and that he be permitted to extend said wires along and under the public roads and highways throughout the said village of Bronson, Sabine County Texas, provided that said improvements are so constructed, operated and maintained so as not to interfere with the public use and safety of said roads, nor to damage said roads and to conform at all times with the orders of the court. That the following persons be appointed presiding officers of a special election to be holden in their respective precincts, on Monday, August 1, A. D. 1927. Each of whom shall select from the qualified voters of his precinct, two judges and two clerks to assist him in said election:

Hemphill, H. B. Arnold, Fairdale, J. T. McGraw, Brookeland, D. E. Willis, Milam, Mack McGown, Sexton, D. B. Polley, Rosevine, J. T. Fuller, Yellowpine, John Walker, Geneva, R. W. Harris, Bronson, Jeff Burns, Isla, Charles Vickers, Pineland Mack Crocker, Fairmount, O. J. Smith, Bayou, W. P. Smith, Sabinetown, Josh Gomer, Strickland Chapel, Julius Harris, Gravel Hill, George Anderson.

It is ordered by the Court, that unless the Sheriff of this county begins at once and continues with the enforcement of all laws pertaining to the operation of motor vehicles upon the public roads of this county and apprehends all persons committing violations of said laws in his presence and in the presence of his deputies, and enforces the law relating to the selling of cigarets in this county, and the law relating to all other occupations upon which a tax is levied including vendors of patent medicines, beginning with July the 31st A. D. 1927 the \$75.00 per month now being paid to the said sheriff for the expense of a guard for the county jail will be discontinued. It is further ordered that the sheriff S. H. Hall, of Sabine County, Texas, be furnished with a copy of this order.

No further business to be transacted, the court adjourned.
