Be it ordered by the Court that J. W. Minton, who is representing the County in the road controversy, with Mrs. Lee Buckley and her heirs, be authorized to offer them \$250.00 in compromise.

On this day came on to be heard the petition of G. A. Boyd and 10 others, asking for a new road beginning at E. J. McGowen's, leading near W. A. Curls' place, and intersecting the State Highway near L. H. Chandlers' place.

Letney, Live Stock inspector, for the County, be authorized and instructed to collect the usual fees for the dipping of cattle up to the time the free dip from the state has been received and use of same commenced, at which time vat charges will be discontinued.

There being no further business, court adjourned.
