The following business was had:

Joe Harper was reappointed Public Weigher. *and his bond approved.*

The bond of V. F. Williams, Deputy Public Weigher, with W. C. Bell, V. B. Ellice and L. E. Pratt, assurities, in the amount of \$1000.00, was approved.

T. G. Stewart was appointed road overseer on a portion of the Carters Ferry road in precinct No. 4.

Ordered by the Court that the pasture made by Oneil and Kirk, either be fenced perfectly stock proof, or that two more gates be placed in said fence, one at or near, the old Spring-hill road, near Hard Travis' place, and the other at or near the Willis Conner place, at the point of intersection of the said fence with said road. And further ordered that they be furnished with a copy of this order.

It is also ordered by the Court that the County Judge be authorized to make the County a party in the Stock Company to the amount of \$1000.00 for the purposes of bringing in a deep water well.

There being no further business, Court adjourned.
