We the undersigned officers holding an election on the 2nd. day of April, 1927, in Common School District No. 31, of said for the purpose of determining whether or not the Commissioners' Court of said County shall be authorized to levy, assess and collect annually a tax of and at the rate of 75% on the \$100.00 valuation of taxable property in said District for the purpose of supplementing the State School Fund apportioned to said District, hereby certify that at said election there were cast 31 votes of which number there were cast for increase of School Tax, 30 votes; against increase of School Tax, 1 vote; making a majority of 29 votes for the increase of School Tax.

On this day came on to be considered the returns of an election held on the 2nd. day of April, A.D. 1927, in Common School District No. 31, of this County, upon the question of levying a tax of 75% on the \$100.00 on all taxable property of said District for the purpose of supplementing the State School Fund apportioned to said School District, and it appearing that said election was in all respects legally held, and that said returns were duly and legally made, and that there were cast at said election 31 votes, of which number there were cast for the increase of School Tax 30 votes, against the increase of School Tax, 1 vote; and it further appearing to the Court from said returns that a majority of the qualified property tax paying voters of said District voting at said election voting in favor of said increase of said tax, and authorizing the said Commissioners' Court to levy, assess and collect annually a tax of, and at the rate of, 75% on the \$100.00 valuation of taxable property in said District for said purpose, the Court does hereby declare the proposition for the tax to be adopted.
