The following business was had.

Accounts as per account ledger were allowed and approved.

The monthly report of the tax collector was approved.

Ordered that the county Treasurer transfer \$1000.00 out of the Road and Bridge refunding fund, No. 2, into the Road and Bridge fund.


That the County treasurer transfer P. I. County funds, out of Commissioners precincts Nos. 1, 3, and 4, into the I. I. fund as follows: \$43.50, out of No. 1, \$190.37, out of No. 4, and \$4.94, out of No. 3.

That the tax collector be authorized to collect from H. Kempner, on a basis of \$800.00 valuation on 100 acres of the Henry Nichols survey, instead of \$880.00, there being an error amounting to the difference of \$80.00 in the notice Kempner received from the County Clerk, relative to the raising of valuation made by the board of equalization.

That the 116 acres on the A. Russell survey owned by J. C. Chance be reduced from \$9.00 per acre to \$5.00 per acre, there being an error in the assessment.

There being no further business, court adjourned.
