The following business among others were had:

Ordered Non pro Tunc: That the Co. Judge be allowed \$3.00 per day for holding Commissioners Court.

That W. J. Davis be appointed Constable at Sexton, Justice Precinct No \_\_\_\_\_. That H. W. Murphy be appointed Justice of the Peace of said Precinct.

A petition was presented to the Court signed by J. W. Minton and 13 others, praying to be annexed to hog law territory adjacent to their land, and it appearing to the Court all things considered, that the law applicable to such annexation was fully complied with, the petition is granted.

The County Treasurers' and Tax Collector's monthly reports were each approved.  
Ordered by the Court that Competative bids for the operation of the ferry at Pendleton be received by the county Judge up until 10:00 O'clock Friday, December 30th, 1927, and notice thereof to be published in the Sabine County Reporter. The Court reserves a right to reject any and all bids.

There being no further business, Court adjourned.

PETITION TO ADD TERRITORY TO STOCK LAW DISTRICT.

TO THE HONORABLE COMMISSIONER'S COURT OF SABINE COUNTY TEXAS.

We, the undersigned persons, owners of the hereinafter described lands which adjoin lands in which a Stock law prevails and in which hogs, sheep and goats are not permitted to run at large, hereby petition your Honorable Body to include the following lands and territory in said stock law territory and that you pass an order extending the Stock Law, forbidding the running at large of hogs, sheep and goats in such territory, said territory being described as follows:

Beginning at the southwest corner of a 7 acre tract on the Joseph Walker survey, owned by J. O. Toole, said point being on the south line of the present Stock Law territory. Thence east with the Hemphill and Sabine town road to the N. E. corner of a 12 acre tract owned by the Sabine Valley association, same being the N. W. corner of a 16-2/10 acres. Thence easterly with the S. line of said 16-2/10 acre tract to the N. W. corner of a 29 acre tract owned by L. H. Dent, thence S. with the W. E. line of said L. H. Dent, 29 acre tract to its S. W. corner. Thence westerly with the N. line of Hamilton & Minton's 49 acres to the S. W. corner of the A. G. Pratt 20 acres. Thence northerly with the W. E. line of said Pratt 20 acres to the S. E. line of a 2 acre tract known as the Colored Church tract. Thence westerly with the S. line of the Colored Church 2 acre tract to its S. W. corner. Thence northerly with the W. E. line of the Church tract to its N. W. corner. Thence easterly with H. Milton & Minton line to their N. W. corner. Thence S. 17 E with E. E. line of Mrs. L. M. Kinix to the S. E. line of the Joseph Walker survey. Thence easterly with the S. E. line of the Joseph Walker survey, to its S. E. cor. Thence S. 10 W. with the E. E. line of the Ben Franklin survey to the S. W. cor. of a 57 acre tract on T. & No. O. Ry Co. Section 16 owned by F. P. Gandy. Thence east with the S. line of F. P. Gandy's 57 acre tract to his S. E. corner on the divisional line to the T. & No. O. Ry Co., Section 16. Thence N. with said divisional line and F. P. Gandy's line to the S. line of the Sam Adams pre-emption survey. Thence east with Sam Adams' S. E. line to its S. E. corner. Thence north with the Henry Nichols Labor line to the N. W. corner of the Henry Nichols Labor. Thence East with the North line of the Henry Nichols and the S. line of the Hamp Bush survey to the S. E. corner of the Hamp Bush survey. Thence north with Hamp Bush' E. E. line to its N. E. corner. Thence continuing north with the E. line of a subdivision of the W. A. Malin owned by Hamilton & Minton to the S. line of the T. B. Watson survey. Thence west with the S. line of the T. B. Watson survey to its S. W. corner. Thence N. 12 W. with T. B. Watson's W. E. line to the S. line of the Gustavus Hart survey. Thence west with the S. line of the Gustavus Hart survey to the Southeast corner of a 125 acre subdivision of said Hart survey owned by C. W. Eliphint. Thence continuing west with the south line of said Hart survey to the N. E. corner of the F. D. Gooch survey. Thence S. 12 E. with the E. E. line of the south line of the F. D. Gooch survey to the E. E. line of the Joseph Walker survey. Thence north 16W. with the E. E. line of the Joseph Walker survey to the S. E. corner of a 50 acre subdivision on the Joseph Walker survey owned by J. O. Toole. Thence westerly with the S. line of said J. O. Toole 50 acre subdivision to the N. W. corner of the Dave Smith 33 acre subdivision. Thence S. with the W. E. line of Dave Smith's 33 acre subdivision to its S. W. corner same being the N. E. corner of a 7 acre subdivision owned by J. W. Toole. Thence westerly with the N. line of the J. O. Toole 7 acre subdivision to its N. W. corner. Thence southerly with the W. E. line of said J. O. Toole 7 acre subdivision to the place of beginning.
