The following orders were passed.

Ordered by the Court, That Mrs. Emma Lee of Bronson, be allowed \$10.00 County aid.

That the acreage of F. S. Morrison, of Brookeland, be reduced from 11 acres to one acre on account of error in assessment, and that his taxes be figured on that basis accordingly.

That M. L. Ener's road tax be figured on rates of District No. 4, instead of District No. 5, as the property of Mr. Ener is located in District No. 4 and not in no. 4. That he be refunded in what ever proportional amount the rate of District No. 5 would exceed the rate of District No. 4.

That minutes of accounts allowed, were read and approved.
