
The Honorable Commissioner's court, in and for Sabine County, Texas, met in special session, February 26th, 1928, at the regular meeting place thereof, in the court house, with all members being present to-wit:

The Following business was transacted:

Accounts were allowed, as per account ledger.

The Ladies' of the Civic League, through their representatives, Mrs. E. H. Murphy, and Mrs. C. M. Atham, presented in behalf of the Civic League, the following request, That the said Civic League be authorized and given permission by the Commissioner's Court to move the Court House fence and to exercise their discretion as to the hedge on the inside of the fence, and to plant shrubbery along side the walks and around the court house pavement, upon which request the following action was taken by the Commissioners Court; Motion by E. J. McGown, seconded by J. A. Hyden, that the said request be granted in every respect save and except the part asking for permission to move the hedge which part is for the present time refused, all members voting "AYE".

Mrs. L. M. Knox, made the following request, to the court: That the hedge around the Court house square and the concrete steps be left undisturbed, under condition that she will cultivate and prune the hedge and donate money to civic league, or any organization organized for the same or similar purposes, conditioned further that in the event at any future time said hedge or steps should seem to be non-conducive, to the best appearance of the square, generally, then and in that event, said steps and hedge may be removed. This request was not officially acted upon, at this time, but it was conceded and generally understood by the members of the court, that the temporary refusal of the request of the Civic League, with reference to the hedge, amounted to the granting of Mrs. L. M. Knox's request temporarily, or until such time as might seem necessary to determine whether it would or would not be the best interest of all concerned.

Ordered by the Court that the Security Trust Company, of Austin Texas, be authorized to exchange \$11,000.00 general funding warrants, issue of September 1st, 1926, for a like amount of general funding warrants of issue prior to September 1st, 1926. Said exchange to be made with H. C. Burt and Company of Houston, Texas.

A petition by H. B. Arnold and four others, having lands adjacent to hog law territory, and asking that said lands be annexed to said territory was granted.

A petition by W. C. Conner and 13 others, asking that a portion of the old Brookeland road from G. H. Ferrin's place to W. C. Conners' may be re-established as a public road, was presented to the court, for the second time, but no action was had thereon.

There being no further business, court adjourned, until 27th and on this day with all members being present, was had the following business, to-wit: By virtue of the death of County Clerk, Jno. Harper, which occurred on February 25th, 1928, it becoming the duty of the court to appoint his successor, and among other petitions that of his wife Mrs. Berta Harper, being presented for nomination, and out of respect of the deceased clerk, the petition of Mrs. Berta Harper, was first presented to the Court for consideration, whereupon a motion by J. D. Edgar, seconded by J. A. Hyden, that she be appointed successor to her husband, was unanimously carried. Mrs. Harper, immediately made bond took the oath of office and the bond was approved.

There being no further business court adjourned.

TO THE HONORABLE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF SABINE COUNTY.

We, the undersigned persons, owners of the hereinafter described lands which adjoin lands on the south side in which hogs, sheep and goats are not permitted to run at large, hereby petition your Honorable Body to include the following lands and territory in said stock law territory and that you pass an order extending the stock law forbidding the running at large of hogs, sheep and goats in such territory, said territory being described as follows:

Beginning at the northwest corner of the Wright Coley survey in the south boundary line of the John Smith survey. Thence S. 2 E. 955 vrs. to corner, being one of the corners of the Goodrich & Arnold 400 acre tract. Thence N. 58 1/2 W. 275 vrs. another corner of said Goodrich & Arnold 400 acres. Thence S. 31 1/2 E. 900 vrs. to corner. Thence S. 56-3/4 W. 1013 vrs. to corner in north line of the H. C. Carlton tract. Thence west with Carlton's line to his most northerly corner. Thence S. 25 W. 350 vrs. to Boyd Creek. Thence down Boyd creek to corner of a 50 acre tract owned by Mrs. Lorena Webb. Thence east with the N. E. line of Mrs. Webb's 50 acres to her N. E. corner in the W. B. line of Mrs. Lora Dickerson's west line to the Pologoch creek. Thence down said creek with its meanders to the S. E. corner of lands owned by Mrs. Y. E. Buckley. Thence northerly with Mrs. Buckley's east line to the S. W. corner of 110 acres owned by Mrs. Buckley. Thence easterly with the S. E. line of said 110 acres to its S. E. corner, same being the N. W. corner of the Toole tract. Thence easterly with the N. B. line of said Toole tract to the E. B. line of the Ira McDaniel survey. Thence northerly with the E. B. line of said Ira McDaniel survey to the S. E. corner of 77 acres owned by Temple Lumber Company. Thence N. 78 1/2 W. with the S. B. line of said Temple Lumber Co. 77 acres 1106 vrs. to the W. B. line of said Ira McDaniel survey. Thence N. 22 E. with said line to the N. W. corner of said McDaniel survey on the south line of the John Smith headright survey. Thence N. 70 W. with Smith's S. B. line to the place of beginning.
