Conner for the right and privilege of aforesaid persons to erect, construct, operate and maintain an electric light and water plant in the town of Bronson, Sabine County, Texas, and for the right to erect light poles and electric wires, and to build and construct water lines and water mains, and to construct such tanks and such other material things as are necessary to operate and maintain an electric light and water plant for the town of Bronson and adjacent thereto, in Sabine County, Texas, along, over, under, by and across the Public Streets, alleys, of town of Bronson, and along, over, under, by and across the Public Highways leading into the town of Bronson, Sabine County, Texas, that are adjacent to town of Bronson.
