

The Hon. Commissioners' Court in and for Sabine county, Texas, met in Regular Session at the regular meeting place thereof, the Second Monday in May, the same being the 14th day of May, A.D. 1928, all members being present, to-wit:

The following orders were passed:

The State of Texas, (On this the 14 day of May, 1928, the Commissioners' Court of County of Sabine. (Sabine County, Texas, was convened in regular session at the May regular term thereof, the County Judge and all of the County Commissioners and the County Clerk being present, when among other business transacted, the following order was passed by a vote of 4 votes for its passage to 0 votes against its passage, to-wit:

WHEREAS, there are certain county Road and Bridge scrip or warrants outstanding and unpaid which are a legal charge against Sabine county, and this court having had under consideration the advisability and necessity for extending the time of payment and issuing in lieu thereof interest bearing time warrants; and it appearing to this Court that in the issuance of warrants in lieu of which the warrants hereinafter described were issued, evidencing the expenditure of Two Thousand (\$2000.00) Dollars, or more, the contract furnishing the basis for such expenditure was first submitted to competitive bids, after prior notice by publication as required by law, except where any one of said warrants represents the aggregate amount of separate and independent contracts of purchase of materials and the performance of labor, such warrants being issued to cover the aggregate total; and it further appearing to this Court that in the issuance of each of the warrants hereinafter set forth evidencing the expenditure of less than Two Thousand (\$2000.00) Dollars and more than Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars, the contract furnishing the basis of said expenditure was first submitted to competitive bids, and said contract was awarded upon competitive bids in each instance, at a regular term of the Court, except in those instances where said warrants represent expenditures for work done under the immediate supervision of the Commissioners' Court and to be paid for by the day; and

And it further appearing to this Court that it is necessary and advisable to issue funding warrants for the purpose of funding said outstanding scrip or warrants and issuing to the holders thereof interest bearing time payment warrants; and

WHEREAS, there are no funds now available to pay road and bridge expenses, and it will be necessary to issue scrip against said county in payment of claims covering expenses incurred for Road and Bridge purposes; and

WHEREAS, the J.R. Phillips Investment Company of Houston, Texas, has agreed to purchase and take up from the holders thereof, all scrip already issued and hereinbefore listed, and all scrip to be legally issued for purposes hereinbefore stated against Sabine county, to the extent of Thirty Thousand (\$30,000.00) Dollars (which amount includes said scrip or warrants now outstanding and those hereafter to be issued); and has further agreed with the Commissioners' Court of said County to accept in lieu thereof and in full satisfaction of said scrip so purchased and to be purchased by them "SABINE COUNTY ROAD AND BRIDGE FUNDING WARRANTS" bearing interest at the rate of six per cent (6%) per annum;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS:

That the scrip herein listed, aggregating the sum of Fifteen Thousand, Two Hundred Eighteen 72/100 (\$15,218.72) Dollars be and the same is hereby in all things adjudicated and held and declared to be valid, subsisting, binding and unsatisfied obligations against Sabine County, and the acts of the county officers in issuance of said scrip are hereby in all things ratified and confirmed.

That claims to the extent of Fourteen Thousand, Seven Hundred, Eighty One & 28/100 (\$14,781.28) Dollars, legally issued for Road and Bridge expenses of Sabine County, and claims legally incurred against said County, shall be paid and evidenced by the issuance of county scrip.

The State of Texas,) This contract made and entered into this 14 day of May, A.D. 1928, between M.H. Thomas, hereinafter called party of the first

part, and the Commissioners, Court of Sabine County, Texas, hereinafter called party of the second part, WITNESSETH:

1. Party of the first part agrees, binds and obligates himself to repair the gutters and curbs, and top out the walk around the Court House Square, in the town of Hemphill, Texas, furnishing all labor necessary to complete said work, and to complete same in as short a time as possible consistent with good work.

2. It is agreed that said work shall be done under the supervision of the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas, and in accordance with plans and specifications furnished by said Court; and that materials used in said work shall be as follows:

For all concrete work - a mixture of 1 part cement, 2 parts of sand and 4 parts gravel; for all topping for walks and curb a mixture of 1 part cement to 2 parts sand; and all work shall be finished in a neat and workmanlike manner.

3. All materials used in construction of said work shall be furnished by party of the second part.

4. Party of the second part agrees, binds and obligates itself, to pay to party of the first part, for labor furnished and work done on said job, the sum of Sixty-two & 50/100 Dollars (\$62.50) per day for each day work is done on said job.

5. It is agreed that party of the first part shall have the right to draw as much as fifty per cent (50%) of the estimated complete contract price for work on entire job as the work progresses, said amount to be agreed upon by the parties hereto, this provision being made for the purpose of enabling party of the first part to take care of labor pay-rolls, and such payment to be made at the end of the first weeks work on said job.

Balance due under this contract shall be paid to party of the first part by party of the second part, upon the completion and acceptance of said work.
