There was also upon attendance of said Court, O.M. Bennett, Tax Assessor in and for Sabine County, Texas, and Mrs. Berta Harper, County Clerk in and for Sabine County, Texas, represented by her duly appointed deputy, D.A. Sibley.

The Court finding it necessary and their duty to raise the assessment of various property owners, passed the following order, to-wit:

It is ordered by the Board of Equalization that Mrs. Berta Harper, County Clerk, Sabine County, Texas, give each person who rendered the properties which are to be raised 10 days written notice that the Board desires to raise the valuation of same.

The Board will re-convene as a Board of Equalization Monday, June 18th, 1928, at 9:00 o'clock A.M. Those who wish to protest are requested to meet the Board on that date, unless otherwise notified.
