SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT.

On this 9 day of July 1928, between Gulf Colorado and Santa Fe Railway Company, Lessor, Gulf Beaumont and Great Northern Railway, a Texas Corporation, hereinafter called Railway Company, and Sabine County, Texas, a political subdivision of the State of Texas, hereinafter called "County".

RECEIVED: On January 27th, 1926, the parties entered into an agreement (Railway Company's Secretary's No. 15035), hereinafter referred to as "Original Agreement", whereby Railway Company, licensed County to use a certain portion of its station grounds at Brookeland, Sabine County, Texas, for a dipping vat. The parties now desire to change the rental provision in said Original Agreement, as hereinafter provided.

AGREEMENT.

ARTICLE 1.

THE PARTIES MUTUALLY AGREE:

1. That effective January 27th, 1926, the following shall be and the same is hereby substituted for the rental provision of Original Agreement: "The Licensee hereby agrees to pay to the licensor in advance, as compensation for the rights and privileges in this license mentioned, the sum of \$5.00 per year."

2. That original agreement, as hereinabove amended, shall be and remain in full force and effect during the term thereof.
