

The Honorable Commissioners Court met in Special Session, July 23, 1928 at the regular meeting place, in the court house, with the following members being present to-wit:

The following business was transacted:

Ordered by the Court that the Ferry Boat on Sabine River, at Pendleton Crossing, be condemned until same can be replaced with a new boat. In the meantime all persons crossing same do so at their own risk.

It is ordered by the court that the County Judge, be authorized to advertise for bids for the construction of a new ferry boat, in the Hemphill Reporter, said bids to be received in the office of the County Judge, up till 12:00 O'clock on August 13th 1928, detailed specifications to be had on application to the County Judge, office.
