BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY SCHOOL TRUSTEES OF SABINE COUNTY TEXAS:

That (a) Plainview Common School District No. 31, of said County be (b) Re-established, in accordance with the constitution and laws of this State, and said District is by this order (b) Reestablished, within the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

We, the undersigned, qualified property taxpaying voters of Common School District No. 31, in Plainview, Sabine County, pray that an election be ordered to be held in said District to determine whether a majority of the legally qualified property taxpaying voters of said District desire the issuance of bonds, numbered consecutively from one to two, both inclusive, to become due and payable 20 years after date, optional after 10 years, of the denomination of (a) \$500.00 each aggregating (b) \$1,000.00, bearing interest at the rate of (c) ~~4~~ 6% per cent per annum, payable annually, April 10th of each year, said bonds to be expended in payment of accounts legally contracted in (f) Building and equipping an addition of wood to the present wood school building in Plainview Common School District No. 31, Sabine County, Texas, and to determine whether the Commissioner's Court of said County shall be authorized to levy, assess and collect annually while said bonds, or any of the, are outstanding, a tax upon all taxable property within said district sufficient to pay the current interest on said bonds and provide a sinking fund sufficient to pay the principal at maturity.
