

The Commissioners Court convened again in Regular Session Fri. 14th day of December, 1928, with all members present, to-wit: R. H. Dent, County Judge, E. J. McCown, Commissioner Precinct No. 1, J. A. Hyden, Commissioner, Precinct No. 2, J. D. Edgar, Commissioner Precinct No. 3, and H. C. Travis Commissioner Precinct No. 4, and transacted business as follows:

Ordered by the Court that the land of Mrs. L. M. Knox, along the various State & Lateral Highways, or such portion of same as is needed to the County for the use of Highways & highway purposes, be eliminated from the Tax Assessments, and that all assessments for County District School and Road District be cancelled from and after the date of the creation of said Road districts. The Tax Collector is hereby authorized and directed to accept payment, less the amount Taxes due on above lands as enumerated.

Ordered by the Court that the part of the road between the point of intersection via T. G. Speights, and the Corporate Limits of Memphis, the part from the other west tract line, extending back north for the balance of said road be discontinued as a road of the 2nd class.
