

The Honorable Commissioner's Court, in and for Sabine County, Texas, met in special session January 28th, 1929, at the Court house in Hemphill, with all members being presents to-wit: R. H. Dent, County Judge, E. J. McGown, Comm. Precinct No. 1, J. D. Edgar, Comm. Precinct No. 2, J. A. Hyden, Comm. Precinct No. 3, and J. E. Minton, Comm. Precinct No. 4, and transacted the following business, to-wit:

Be it ordered by the Court that the Bond of T. I. Chambers, as Justice of the Peace and Exofficio Notary Public, for Precinct No. 4, be approved.

That the quarterly report of the County Treasurer be approved.

Upon oral petition of H. D. Bickley, Constable, Precinct No. 1, that a Deputy Constable be appointed, It was teerefore ordered, by the court, that A. J. Alford, be appointed as Deputy Constable, Precinct No. 2, Sabine County, Texas.

It is also ordered by the Court, that County Judge, R. H. Dent, be authorized to supervise the repair of the Co. Jail in that of seeing that all necessary locks are installed and that the sheriff Department, be furnished with all the keys.

That there is set aside for each commissioner's Beet, out of the Road and Bridge funds, the following amounts: Beet No. 1, \$4900.00. Beet No. 2, \$3400.00. Beet No. 3, \$3700.00. Beet No. 4, \$3400.00. provided that all excess or overdraft of the previous year in each beet shall be deducted from the present setoffs.

No further business, Court adjourned.
