Whereas, heretofore, to-wit: on the 14th day of May, 1928, the Commissioners' Court of  
Sabine County, Texas, passed an order authorizing the issuance of \$50,000 road and Bridge  
funding warrants for the purpose of funding \$50,000 outstanding scrip or warrants against the  
road and Bridge Fund of said County, and for the further purpose of funding warrants issued  
in payment of valid indebtedness incurred in the construction of improvements, purchase of  
materials, and other expenses incurred under the provisions of the laws of the State of Texas  
and the acts of the legislature referred to in said order, which order is recorded in the  
minutes of said court, and

Whereas, in pursuance of said order, certain scrip or warrants have been issued against  
the Road and Bridge fund of Sabine County, in payment of claims which were duly audited and al-  
lowed, by the Commissioners' Court of said County prior to the issuance of said warrants, and  
which are valid, subsisting and binding obligations against Sabine County, said warrants,  
being as follows:

AMENDATORY ORDER.

being present, and, among other proceedings, passed the following order:

Whereas, on the 10th day of December 1928, this court passed an order, authorizing the  
issuance of \$1,000.00 bonds of Common School District No. 31, of said County, which order is  
of record in Book M. page 511, of the Minutes of said court; and

Whereas, two tax rates are provided in section LX, of said order; and

hereas, it appearing to the court that a tax rate of seven cents is sufficient.

Therefore, be it ordered by the Commissioners court of Sabine County, Texas:

That Section LX, of the above mentioned order be, and the same is hereby, amended to  
hereafter read as follows;

LX.

It is further ordered by the Court that to pay the current interest on said bonds and  
created a sinking fund sufficient to redeem them at maturity, a tax of seven cents on each  
one Hundred Valuation of all taxable property in said Plainview Common School District No. 31,  
shall be annually levied on said property and annually assessed and collected, or so much  
thereof as may be necessary, until said bonds with interest thereon have been fully paid, and  
the said tax of seven cents is here and now levied for the year 1929, and so much thereof, as  
may be necessary for each succeeding year while said bonds, or any of them are outstanding,  
and unpaid, and the same shall be assessed and collected for the year 1929, and so much thereof  
of as may be necessary annually thereafter and applied to the purpose named.
