

The Honorable Commissioners Court, met in regular session, March, 11th, 1929, with all members being present, to wit: R. H. Dent, County Judge, E. J. McGowen, Comm. Prec. #1, J. A. Hyden, Comm. Prec. #2, W. D. Edgar, Comm. Prec. No. 3, and J. E. Minton, Comm. Prec. No. 4, Mrs. Berta Harper, County Clerk, E. B. Smith, Sheriff.

Some accounts were allowed, and the following orders were passed:

Be it ordered by the Court that all County officers are forbidden to incur County expense of any kind without the premission of the Commissioners Court and be it further ordered that this shall be constructive notice to all parties making accounts that the County will not be bound for any obligations unauthorized as before set out. Be it further ordered that each Co. officer be furnished a copy of this order; But it is stipulated herein that should any emergency or pressing necessity arise between sessions of the Court that the County Judge be hereby authorized to act, as purchasing agent for County supplies.

It is ordered by the Court that L. L. Sanders, Enoch Key, and ----- Anderson, each be allowed \$10.00 Co. Aid. The Clerk is hereby authorized to draw a warrant in favor of each for \$10.00 out of the Gen Fund of the County.

It is ordered by the Court that the Co. Clerk be allowed \$25.00, quarterly renumeration, beginning Jan, 1st, 1929, for posting finance ledger, in compliance with Article 1644, R.U.S.

It is also ordered by the Court that R. H. Dent, be allowed \$7.50, for expenses of School Trustee elections.

The petition of W. R. Mickey, asking that certain lands be included in Stock law territory was presented to the Court, which petition was granted.

Be it ordered by the Court that the Road Tax District #3, paid by L. C. Gray, of Geneva, 30 acres, J. I. 30 acres of the J. I. Pifirmo #47, for years 1924-1926 and 1927, be refunded as the Land above referred to is not located in the said district No. 3. The Tax Collector is hereby authorized to refund the amount of 9.78 amount of cash on hand and charge same to Road District aforesaid.

There being no further business, Court adjourned.
