

ORDER DECLARING RESULT OF BOND ELECTION
IN COMMON SCHOOL DISTRICT No. 29.

In the Commissioners' Court of Sabine County.

On this the 11 day of March, A. D. 1929, came on to be considered the returns of an election held on the 2 day of March, A. D. 1929, in Campground Common School District No. 29, of this County, upon the question of issuing One Thousand (\$1000.00,) Dollars, of schoolhouse Bonds, for said District, running 20 years, and bearing 5 per centum interest, and levying a tax upon all taxable property within said District sufficient to pay the current interest on said bonds and provide a sinking fund sufficient to pay the principal at maturity, and

It appearing that said election was in all respects legally held and that said returns were duly and legally made and that there were cast at said election 32 votes, of which number there were cast;

"For the issuance of bonds and the levying of the tax in payment thereof" ----- 32 votes.

"Against the issuance of bonds and the levying of the tax in payment thereof" --- 00 votes.

And it appearing to the Court from said returns that a majority of the legally qualified property taxpaying voters of said District, voting at said election, voted for the issuance of said bonds, the Court does hereby declare the proposition for the issuance of said bonds, to have been adopted, and that this court is authorized to issue said bonds and to levy and to have assessed and collected said tax.

ORDER AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS
IN COMMON SCHOOL DISTRICT No. 29.

In the Commissioners' Court of Sabine County,

On this, the 11 day of March, A. D. 1929, the Commissioners' court of Sabine County Texas convened in regular session, all the members thereof, to-wit: R. H. Dent, County Judge, E. J. McGown, Commissioner, Precinct No. 1, J. A. Hyden, Commissioner, Precinct No. 2, J. D. Edgar, Commissioner, Precinct No. 3, J. E. Minton, Commissioner, Precinct No. 4, being present, and among other proceedings, passed the following order:

Whereas, at an election held for the purpose on the 2nd day of March, A. D. 1929, a majority of the legally qualified resident property tax paying voters of Camp Ground Common School District No. 29, of this County, having at said election, voted in favor of the issuance of the bonds herein after described and in favor of the tax hereinafter levied;

Therefore, be it ordered by the Commissioners' Court of Sabine County, Texas:

That the bonds of said District to be called "Camp Ground Common School District No. 29, School house bonds", be issued on the faith and credit of said Camp Ground Common School District No. 29, of said County, as established by order of the Board of County School Trustees, as passed on the 6th day of April, 1921, which order is of record in "Record of School Districts" for the purpose of Building and equipping a Modern School Building.

2.

That said bonds shall be numbered consecutively, from 1 to 2 inclusive, shall be of the denomination of Five Hundred (\$500) Dollars, each, aggregating One Thousand (\$1000.) Dollars.

111.

That said bonds shall be dated the 10th day of April, A. D. 1929, shall become due and payable Twenty years from date or, April, 10 1949, with option of redemption after 10 years,

but, bonds numbered 1 to 2, both inclusive, may be redeemed at the pleasure of said District at any time after 10 years, from their date.

IV.

That said bonds shall bear interest at the rate of 5 per centum per annum, payable annually on the 10th day of April, 1930, and the 10th day of April, of each year.

V.

That the principal of and the interest on said bonds shall be payable upon presentation and surrender of bonds or proper coupons, in lawful money of the United States of America, at the office of the Treasurer of the State of Texas, at Austin, Texas, or at office, of County Treasurer of Sabine County, Texas, or at the Hanover National Bank, of New York, N. W. at the option of the holder.

VI.

That the said bonds shall be signed by the County Judge, countersigned by the County Judge, countersigned by the County Clerk, and registered by the County Treasurer, and the seal of the Commissioners' Court shall be impressed upon each of them; the fac-simile signature of the County Judge and County Clerk, may be printed or lithographed on the Coupons.

VII.

That the form of each of said bonds shall be substantially as follows:

CAMP GROUND COMMON SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 29, SCHOOLHOUSE BONDS:

This is to certify that the County of Sabine, in the State of Texas, for and on behalf of Camp Ground Common School District No. 29, of said County, hereby promises to pay, to bearer on the 10th day of April, A. D. 1929, the sum of Five Hundred 500. Dollars, in lawful money of the United States of America, together with interest thereon from the date hereof, at the rate of 5 per centum per annum, interest payable annually on the 10th day of April, 1930, and the 10th day of April, of each year, principal and interest payable upon presentation and surrender of bond or proper coupon at the office of the Treasurer of the State of Texas, at Austin Texas, or at office, on County Treasurer of Sabine County, Texas, or at the Hanover National Bank of New York, N. Y. at the option of the holder.

This bond is one of a series of two bonds, numbered consecutively from 1 to 2 inclusive, of the denomination of Five Hundred \$500. Dollars, each, aggregating One Thousand (\$1000.) Dollars, issued by the Commissioners Court of said County on the faith and credit of Camp Ground Common School District No. 29, of said County as established by order of the Board of County School as passed on the 6 day of April, 1921, which order is of record in "Record of School Districts" for the purpose of building and equipping a modern school building, within said District, for said Camp Ground, Common School District No. 29, under and by virtue of Sections 1 to 12 both inclusive, of Chapter 24 of the General Laws passed by the Thirty-seventh Legislature of the State of Texas, at its Regular Session in 1921, and the Constitution and laws of said State, and in pursuance of an order passed by the Commissioners' Court, of Sabine County, Texas, on the 11 day of March, A. D. 1929, which order is of record in Book, M. pages -- of the minutes of said Court.

The said Camp Ground Common School District No. 29, has and hereby reserves the right to redeem this bond at any time after 10 years from its date by paying principal and accrued interest, and in case the same shall be called in for redemption before maturity notice thereof in writing shall be given by the President of the District Trustees of said Camp Ground Common School District No. 29, to the County Treasurer of said County, at least thirty days before the date fixed for redemption, and should this bond not be presented for redemption it shall

cease to bear interest from and after the date so fixed for redemption.

The date of this bond, in conformity with the order above mentioned, is the 10th day of April, A. D. 1929.

And it is hereby certified and recited that all acts, conditions, and things, required to be done precedent to and in the issuance of this bond have been properly done, happened and performed, in regular and due form as required by law, and that the amount of this issue of bonds does not exceed any constitutional or statutory limitation.

In testimony whereof, said Commissioners' court of Sabine County, Texas, has caused the seal of said Court to be hereto affixed and this bond to be signed by the County Judge, countersigned by the County Clerk, and registered by the County Treasurer of the date last above named.
