were duly and legally made and that there were cast at said election 32 votes, of which number there were cast; "For the issuance of bonds and the levying of the tax in payment thereof" ----- 32 votes.

"Against the issuance of bonds and the levying of the tax in payment thereof" --- 80 votes. And it appearing to the Court from said returns that a majority of the legally qualified property taxpaying voters of said District, voting at said election, voted for the issuance of said bonds, the Court does hereby declare the proposition for the issuance of said bonds, to have been adopted, and that this court is authorized to issue said bonds and to levy and to have assessed and collected said tax.
