

The Commissioner's court Court in and for Sabine County, Texas met in Special Session, May 6th, 1929 with the following members being presents to-wit: J. E. Minton, Commissioner Precinct No. 4, J. D. Edgars, Commissioner Precinct No. 3, J. A. Huden, Commissioner No. 2, and E. J. McGown, Commissioner Precinct No. 1, Mrs. Berta Harper, County Clerk, and transacted the following business.

Mr. J. D. Edgar was appointed by the Commissioner's as Judge Pro-tempore.

On this day came on to be considered the returns of an election held at Pleasant Hill and Yellowpine, upon the question consolidating the Yellowpine and Pleasant Hill schools. And it appearing that said election was in all respects legally held, and that said returns were duly and legally made, and that there cast at said election, 12 votes at Yellowpine and 14 votes at Pleasant Hill, of which numbers, there were cast for the Consolidation of the schools, at Yellowpine 11 votes, and at Pleasant Hill 8 votes, and against the consolidation, of the schools, 1 vote at Yellowpine, and 6 votes at Pleasant Hill. It further appearing to the court from said returns that the majority of the qualified voters of said Districts voting at each election in favor of said Consolidation, the Court does hereby declare the Yellowpine School District #11 and Pleasant Hill School District No. 8 duly consolidated.

There being no further business, Court adjourned.
