On this 13th day of June, 1929, came on to be considered the returns of an election held on the 4th day of May, A. D. 1929, in Common School District No. 29, upon the question of levying a tax of \$1.00, on the \$100.00, on all taxable property of said District for the purpose of supplementing the State School fund appropriated to said District and it appearing that said election was in all respects legally held and that said returns were duly and legally made, and that there were cast at said election 18 votes, of which No. there were cast for the increase of school tax 18 votes, and against the increase, of School Tax No. votes. It further appearing to the Court from said returns that a majority of the qualified property tax paying voters of said District voting at said election, all voted for the increase of said tax, and authorizing the said commissioners' court to levy, assess and collect annually, a tax of and at the rate of \$1.00 on \$100.00 valuation, of taxable property in said district for said purpose. The court does hereby declare the proposition of tax to be adopted.

County Judge's Orders.

Whereas, on the 9 day of April, 1929, a petition was presented to me for an election in Common School District No. 29, of this County on the question of authorizing a tax of and at the rate of One Hundred Cents on the \$100.00 valuation of taxable property in said District, for the purpose of supplementing the State School Fund apportioned to said District, said petition bearing the requisite number of signatures of property taxpaying voters of said District, and being in every respect in conformity with law;

Now, therefore, I R. H. Dent, in my capacity as County Judge, of Sabine County, Texas, do hereby order that an election be held on the 4th day of May, 1929, at The School House, in said Common School District No. 29, of this County as established by order of the Commissioners' Court of this County, of date the 6 day of April, 1921, which is recorded in Book Record S. District, pages 29, of the minutes of said Court to determine whether a majority of the legally qualified property taxpaying voters of that district desire to tax themselves for the purpose of supplementing the State School Fund appointed to said District, and to determine whether the Commissioners' Court of this County shall be authorized to levy, assess and collect annually a tax of and at the rate of one Hundred Cents (\$1.00) on the \$100.00 valuation of taxable property in said District for said purpose.

*J. P. Tatom* is hereby appointed Presiding officer for said election, and he shall select two judges and two clerks to assist him in holding the same, and he shall within five days after said election has been held, make due return thereof to the Commissioners' Court of this County as is required by law for holding a general election.

The Ballots for said election shall have written or printed thereon the following:  
"For Increase School Tax."  
"Against Increase School Tax."

All persons whos are legally qualified voters of this State and of this County, and who are resident property taxpayers of said District shall be entitled to vote at said election.

The Sheriff of this County shall give notice of said election by posting three notices at three public places in the said District.
