The Commiss oners Court re-convened as a Board of Equalization 24 th remained in session up to and including June 27th, 1929, during which time all persons ap earing before the Board were heard and adjustments agreed upon.

The Court adjourned as a Board of Equalization on June 27th, 1929:

Protest was filed with the Court as a Board of Equalization with reference to the values of cut over lands, which lands were raised by the Board from \$5.00 to \$5.50 per acres. Said protests are herein recorded as received:

Comes now, the Southwestern Settlement and Development Company (Not Incorporated), Houston 011 Company of Texas, Kirby Lumber Company and R public Production Company, and file this their protest against the action of the Commissioners court of abine Count, sitting as a Board of Equalization, in reising the rendered value of the property embraced in the rendition filed by them with the Honorable C. M. Bennett, Tax Assessor of said Sabine County, on the 30t day of April, A. D. 1929, for the following reasons;

The values shown apposite the various items of property shown on said rendition represent the actual cash market value of said property on January 1st, 1929, and the action of the Commissioners. Court sitting as a Board of Equalization, in raising said values in arbitrary and contrary to the law, which provides that property for tax purposes shall not be valued in excess of its reasonable cash market value.

The tax records of Sbine County show that personal property generally, situated in Sabine County, is assessed at a value of about fifty per cent of its cash maket value, and that the improved farm lands and all other taxable property generally, in Sabine County, is being valued for tax purposes at not exceeding fifty per cent of its reasonable cash market value. The action of the Commissioners Court sitting as a Board of qualization, in assessing personal property and form lands at not exceeding fifty per cent of their real or each market value, and assessing the property of the Southwestern Settlement and Development Company (Not Incorporated) et al, at its full value, or more than its full value, constitutes an act of discrimination against the said Southwestern Settlement & Development Company, et al, and in favor of the owners of other taxable property in said County, said action being a violation of the provision of the Constitution of the State of Texas, which provides that taxation shall be equal and uniform.
