

The Commissioner's Court of Sabine County, Texas, met in regular session Sept. 9 & 10, 1929, all members present, to-wit: R. H. Dent, County Judge, E. J. McGown, Comm'r Precinct No. 1, J. A. Huden, Comm'r Prec't. No. 2, J. D. Edgar Comm'r Prec't. No. 3 and J. E. Minton Comm'r Prec't. No. 4, Mrs. Berta Harper County Clerk, & E. B. Smith, Sheriff, and transacted business as follows:

The monthly report of County Treasurer, D. A. Sibley, was approved.

A motion by J. D. Edgar, was made that the County Treasurer be authorized to take up at 97 and interest \$1500. or as much as sinking funds would permit above amount needed to defray obligations in said fund, this year, Road District Bonds of Road District #9, being the offer of A. L. Arlit of Austin. Said motion was second by E. J. McGown, and passed by unanimous vote of the court.

A motion by J. D. Edgar, 2nd by J. E. Minton, to purchase a Chalmers 50 model tractor, J. D. Edgar, J. N. Hyden, and E. J. McEown, voting Aye.

Ordered by the Court that L. S. Bell of Brookeland, be permitted to extend his fences at right angles to the bridges up to the ends of said Bridges, on the roads through this and W. C. Bell, land conditioned first that they deed to Sabine County 40 feet of right-of-way along said roads; and conditioned 2nd that fences be not placed under bridges in a manner to make them less durable by reason of the accumulation of drift, and provided further that if fences are removed by the County in building or improving bridges that they be replaced at County expense at the same time removed.

It is also ordered by the Court that the County Treasurer take up all the road and Bridge scrip that funds on hand will permit.

Be it further ordered by the Court that the County Judge advertise for bids on 10 cords of wood bids to be received up to Sept. 23rd, at 2 O'clock.

Be it ordered by the Court that 100 acres of land belonging to Y. C. Jackson, be annexed to hog law territory.

TO THE HONORABLE COMMISSIONER'S COURT OF SABINE COUNTY TEXAS:
