

The Commissioner's Court of Sabine County, met in special session, September 23rd, 1929, with the following members being presents to-wit: R. H. Dent, County Judge, E. J. McGown, Commissioner, Prec. No. 1, J. A. Hyden, Commissioner Prec. No. 2, J. D. Edgar, Commissioner Prec. No. 3, J. E. Manton, Commissioner, Prec. No. 4, and Mrs. Berta Harpre, County Clerk and transacted the following business;

Ordered by the court that Newt Cunningham, of Bronson, be exempt from road duty, on disability certificate furnished by Dr. W. C. Arthur of Bronson, Texas.

That the County Treasurer remit the sum of \$314.48, to the State of Texas, it being the amount the County is due the state as shown by State Audit covering a period of years up to January 1929. Also that the County treasurer be ordered and directed to collect \$794.17, from the First National Bank, County Depository, it being the amount the Bank is due the County, as shown by the same audit.

Two bids were received for 10 cords of wood bid-ers, being J. D. Easley, and Jack Whittlesey, respectively, the bid of J. D. Easley, being \$2.44 per rick, or a little over \$7.00 per cord and the bid of Jack Whittlesey being \$2.20 per rick, or \$6.75 per cord. The bid of Whittlesey, being the lowest he was awarded the contract. The wood must be stacked, and measured before being received and paid for in full.

The rolls of Tax Assessor C. M. Bennett, for 1929, assessment of Taxes, were approved, There being no further business, court adjourned.
