

The Commissioners' Court, in and for Sabine County, Texas, met in Regular Session, November 12th, 1929, with all members being present, to-wit: R. H. Dent, County Judge, E. J. McGown, Comm'r Prec't. No. 1, J. A. Hyden, Comm'r Prec't. No. 2, J. D. Edgar, Comm'r Prec't. No. 3, J. E. Minton, Comm'r Prec't. No. 4, Mrs. Berta Harper, County Clerk, and E. B. Smith, Sheriff, and transacted the following business, to-wit:

Ordered by the Court that the report of County Treasurer be approved.

That the County Treasurer be authorized to place the funds received in three certain Tax Judgments, against James G. Barker, amounting in the aggregate to \$1267.00, to the credit of the General County Fund, and that he be authorized to take up General County Scrip, as far as funds on hand will permit, and he is further ordered and directed to take up scrip in the P. T. and R. & B. funds, to the amount of cash on hand.

It is further ordered, that R. H. Dent, County Judge, be allowed the amount of \$8.00, for expenses incurred in auditing accounts and Delinquent tax record. That he be authorized to use his discretion with reference to the wells and small building, on the square.

It is further ordered by the court that all light-testing stations in Sabine County, be and are hereby cancelled.

There being no further business, court adjourned till Friday the 15th of November, 1929.
