In the Commissioners' court of Sabine County, Texas, at a regular term of said court, on this 15th day of November, 1929, came on to be considered the matter of making permanent repairs to the court house and jail of Sabine County.

And it appearing, affirmatively, to the court, that the court house and jail of Sabine County are in need of permanent repair, and that it is to the best interest of Sabine County, and to its citizens and tax payers, that permanent repairs should be constructed to the court house and jail;

It is therefore ordered by the Commissioners' court of Sabine County, Texas, as follows:

That it is necessary in order to preserve the records of Sabine County, that permanent repairs should be constructed to the Court house and also that it will be to the best interest of Sabine County, and to its citizens and tax payers, that repairs should be constructed to said court house, and also to the jail, and this court has determined and does hereby determine to cause such repairs to be made.

and it further appearing that the County Judge has caused Architectural plans and specifications to be made, which architectural plans and specifications have been made by Theo S. Maffitt, architect, and that said plans and specifications have been inspected by this court the same are hereby approved and adopted as the basis for making such repairs.

It is further ordered that the County Judge of this County be and he is hereby authorized and directed to cause notice to be given as provided by law inviting bids for the constructions, and further orders with reference thereto are reserved until such notice shall have been given.
