

The Commissioners Court met in Special Session Monday, November 25, 1929, with all members presents, to-wit: R. H. Dent, County Judge, E. J. McCown, Commissioner Precinct No. 1, J. A. Hyden, Commissioner Precinct No. 2, J. D. Edgar, Commissioner Precinct No. 3, J. E. Minton, Commissioner Precinct No. 4, Mrs. Berta Harper, County Clerk, and E. B. Smith, Sheriff, and transacted business as follows:

The Memphis Motor Company and The Williams Chevrolet Motor Company, both of Memphis, Texas, the Bronson Motor Company, of Bronson, Texas, and the Brookeland Motor Company, of Brookeland, Texas were appointed County Test Stations for the year 1929-30. They having made bond each in the sum of One Thousand Dollars, and each of the bonds having been approved by the court.

A petition by J. A. Watkins, and either others was presented to the court, asking for the establishment of a public road from the county line of Jasper and Sabine County to the Apostolic Church, situated in the west portion of Brookeland, Texas. Petition granted, provided all necessary right-of-way be furnished free to the County.

Petition as follows:

We the undersigned citizens of Sabine County, Texas, respectfully ask that you grant as a public road running through the lower part of Sabine County, from the County Line of Jasper and Sabine Counties beginning at County Line and running North west to the Apostolic Church, situated in the west portion of Brookeland, Texas. This is a part of the Rural Route from the Brookeland Post Office, the distance of about one mile.

This petition granted conditioned as set out above as a public road of the second class. It is ordered by the court that Mrs. Mollie Lakey of Brookeland, be allowed twenty Dollars County Aid, that Mrs. Socie Rodgers be allowed Six Dollars in addition to what has already been allowed for the care and board of Reb Meador. Each to be paid out of the General County Fund.

It is further ordered by the court that one in the amount of Nine-hundred, forty one dollars be issued to R. B. George Machinery Co. of Dallas, Texas, It being the first payment on one Caterpillar Tractor purchased from said firm, also that warrants be issued to J. D. Adams, Grader Company, for \$ \_\_\_\_\_, it being the price of one No. 10, Adams Leading Wheel Grader.

Each of these warrants to be drawn against the Permanent Improvement Fund. The account of the Roy Washington, Colard, for road, work, in the amount of twenty-five dollars, was presented, to the court and was in all respects refused except that payment will be allowed at some future meeting of the Court for hauling Dynamite from Brookeland, which price will be approximately Five Dollars.

It is further ordered, by the Court that Truda Chance be allowed five Dollars, out of the General County Fund, for clerical services in the office of the County Judge. There being no further business court adjourned.
