

The Honorable Commissioners' Court in and for Sabine County, Texas, reconvened in regular session December 20th, 1929, with the following members presents, to-wit: R. H. Dent, County Judge, E. J. McGown, Comm'r Prect. No. 1, J. A. Hyden, Commr. Prect. No. 2, J. D. Edgar, Comm. Prect. No. 3, J. E. Minton, Comm. Prect. No. 4, Mrs. Berta Harper, County Clerk, and E. B. Smith, sheriff, and transacted the following business;

Bids for the repair of the county court house and jail were received, as follows:
Godart Construction and Equipment Co., San Antonio, bid on Composition of floors: \$2,000.00, that is, for furnishing and installing Acetyled Composition flooring for 2nd floor, exclusive of porch and toilets.

United States Rubber Co, for Asphaltum Ruber Tile in the rooms and floors of 2nd Floor: as follows, Black Asphaltum 1/8 in. \$1017.25. Black Asphaltum 3/16 in. \$1239.00. Red Asphaltum 1/8 In. \$1058.50, Red 3/16 in. \$1321.50. Tan or Ivy Green, 1/8 in. \$1264.00, Tan or Ivy Green 3/16 in \$1523.66.

Mr. House, of Jasper, for complete painting job, exclusive of roof, \$1260.00. If roof is included \$1400.00.

Bid of A. M. Burns, of Palestine, as follows: Plumbing, \$378.00. Electric work. \$1882.00 Sheet Metal work. for court house \$495.00. Sheet Metal work, for Jail \$160.00. Plumbing work for Jail \$475.00. New Roof for Court house Including Sheet Metal work, \$1576.00.

Bid of L. F. Hubley, of Jacksonville, \$14,819.78, according to Alternate No. 1 \$15,610.78. Bid of Koetter and Arbing, for painting court house according to plans and specifications \$2,533.50. If Asbestos shingles are used, deduct from bid \$150.00.

Bid of Waver Bros. of Center, was submitted on material, and on recall, a bid was submitted on labor and materials. After consulting all bids, both general and specific, it was ordered, by the court that all bids on Court House improvements, and also on Jail improvements be rejected and that the County Judge be directed to readvertise for bids to be received at 10 O'clock A.M. on January 24 . . . 1930.

It is ordered by the court that R. H. Dent, County Judge, be allowed \$17.00, expenses of trip to Many, the 2nd Wednesday in December, 1929.

That County Clerk, Mrs. Harper, be allowed \$25.00, for fees, as provided in R.S. 3922.

That E. J. McGown, be allowed \$25.00, expenses to District Court at Beaumont, Each amount to be paid out of the General County fund.

Therebeing no further business to come before the court, it adjourned.
