

The Commissioners' Court in and for Sabine County, Texas, met in Regular session, January 13th, 1930, with the following members presents, to-wit: R.H. Dent, County Judge, E. J. McGown, Commr. Prect. No. 1, J. A. Hyden, Commr. Prect. No. 2, J. D. Edgar, Commr. Prect. No. 3, J. E. Minton, Commr. Prect. No. 4, Mrs. Berta Harper, County Clerk, and transacted the following business, to-wit:

The resignation of M. E. Cooper, as Justice of the Peace, of Precinct No. 2, was presented to the court, and same was accepted, effective this day.

It is ordered by the court that Sheriff, E. B. Smith, be, and is hereby required to assemble funds, the same being proceeds from the tax sale, some eight months ago, of the lands delinquent for taxes, belonging to John B. Christensen, and that he, the sheriff, place same in the hands of the County Treasurer, and this the court demands that he shall do at once.

The following bills were refused by the court:

Dr. W. T. Arnold, and J. B. Rushing, for medical services to A. Halbert, while in hospital, \$15.00.

To two days Hospitalization, rendered by C. F. Smith, \$10.00.

The first on motion, of J. A. Hyden, second by J. E. Minton, the second on motion of E. J. McGown, seconded by J. A. Hyden.

It is also ordered by the court that County aid be allowed to the following persons: John Parker, and M. D. Sparks, each \$7.50, out of the General County Fund, both of these being old men, without means or relatives capable of rendering them support.

It is further ordered by the court that all county convicts, from this time, forward, having unpaid fines, be worked on public roads, and streets, or anywhere their work could be used for public good, that they have credit of \$5.00, for each days work, on the fines they are due. The sheriff is authorized to place said convicts under the supervision of any responsible officer or other person qualified to supervise the labor.

Be it ordered by the court, that the offer of the Memphis Motor Company, of one cab and Body Truck, at \$770.50, be accepted and that warrant on P. I. fund, be issued for same. The other offer being from Williams Chevrolet Co., of Cab Truck, without body, at \$716.00 and was refused.

It is also ordered by the court that County Judge, execute contract with Gulf Refining Company, to furnish Gas & Oil to the County for one year, to be used in County Tractor and County truck, on the lateral roads, in the County. Said contract providing that the gas and Company place tank at County Garage, give discount on purchases at the end of the year and furnish exemption blanks so that the County may get 4% tax refund from the Comptroller's department.

No other business court adjourned, till the 24th day of January, 1930.
