
The Commissioner's Court in and for Sabine County, Texas, reconvened in regular session January 24th, 1930, with the following members present, to-wit: R. H. Dent, County Judge, E. J. Moown, Commr. Prec't. No. 1, J. D. Boggs, Commr. Prec't. No. 3, J. E. Minton, Commr. Prec't. No. 4, and Mrs. Berta Harper, County Clerk, to consider bids for the repair of the Court House and Jail, the following bids being received:

Bid of B. P. Mason, for repairs at 10% above cost of labor and materials or a cost plus bid. Equipment furnished. Sub-contractors to satisfy of architect and Commissioners.

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court. All possible labor hired in the County, that can compete with outside contractors. Clean up and remove all debris.

Bid of J. C. Farly, which bid was as follows: To furnish all labor and materials, complete the Job, exclusive of roofing, for the sum of \$18,560; Alternate: I propose to furnish and apply Jonsmerville 70 pounds Mottled Grey Asbestos shingle, for \$1000.00 additional.

Bid of Godart Construction and Equipment Company, San Antonio. Bid on floors as follows: Composition floors, acetylene flooring, according to specifications furnished and installed for the sum of \$2,000.00.

Bid of M. T. Green, painting, as follows: Walls and sealing as specified; inside wood work, as specified, also inside floors as specified, out side of house as specified, roof as specified, for the sum of \$3,552.00. Alternate: If painting roof is to be omitted, deduct the sum of \$224.00, from the above price.

Bid of S. W. Nichols and Company, for flooring as follows: Flooring, Engineers and contractors, for the sum of \$1,500.00, furnish and install complete, 3/16 in. Tile-Tex, and 6 in. Cove Base, in color combination of red, and black, or mahogany, as follows: on entire second floor with the exceptions of men and women's rest rooms. All stairs, treads and risers from first to third floor. Alternate: If we furnish 3.16 in. Wooster or Blastell, brass nosing, or treads, there will be an additional charge of \$450.00, to the above price.

Bid of L. A. Fuller, as follows: General bid to comply with specification for the sum of \$14,300.00. Alternate: for new roof of asbestos shingles One Thousand Dollars, extra of above and furnishing everything.

Bid of Shelby Roofing Co., by C. P. Scurlock, for R^{pair} work, of roof, on Sabine County Jail, \$156.50, furnishing new gutter, down spouts, flashing and painting, as per plans and specifications.

Bid of Shelby Roofing Co., by C. P. Scurlock, for repair work, of roof, on Sabine County Court House, eternit, 16 X 16, colonel grey, installed, \$1,270.00, as per plans and specifications.

At the conclusion of the opening of bids, motion was made by J. D. Edgar, that all bids be rejected, said motion seconded by J. E. Minton, and the motion carried, by all voting aye.

The court then allowed accounts accruing up to the present and adjourned.
