

The Commissioners' Court, in and for Sabine County, Texas, met in special Session, February 13th, 1930, with R. H. Dent, County Judge, E. J. McGown, Commr. Precinct No. 1, J. D. Edgar, Commr. Precinct No. 2, and Mrs. Berta Harper, County Clerk, and transacted the following business;

The resignation of W. H. Pratt, Justice of the Peace, of Precinct No. 1, was presented to the court. Motion by E. J. McGown, and second by J. D. Edgar, that the resignation be accepted, motion carried.

A petition, asking for the appointment of L. E. King, to succeed Mr. W. H. Pratt as Justice of the Peace, was presented to the court, said petition being signed by O. H. Smith and ten others. Motion to appoint Mr. King, was made by E. J. McGown; second by J. D. Edgar, and motion carried. Petition being as follows:
