

The Honorable Commissioner's Court, in and for Sabine County, Texas, met in regular session, April, 14, 1930, at the regular meeting place thereof, in the court house, with the following members present; to-wit: R. W. Dent, County Judge, E. J. McGowen, Comm'r Prec't. 1, J. A. Hyden, Comm'r Prec't No. 2, J. D. Edgar, Comm'r Prec't No. 3, J. E. Minton, Comm'r Prec't. No. 4, Mrs. Bertha Harper, County Clerk, and E. B. Smith, Sheriff, and transacted the following business, to-wit:

Accounts were allowed as per account ledger.

It is ordered by the court that First National Bank, of Hemphill, Texas, County Depository, is hereby authorized and instructed to remit the sum of Eighteen Hundred Dollars (\$1800) the same being the County's part in State Aid Project Job Mill, Federal Aid Project in Sabine County, Texas, on highway No. 87.

The resignation of L. E. King, as Justice of the Peace, Prec't. No. 1, was presented to the Court, and on motion of J. D. Edgar, and second by J. A. Hyden, said resignation was accepted.

It is ordered by the court, that W. H. Pratt, be appointed as Justice of the Peace, Prec't. No. 1, to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of L. E. King, the bond of W. H. Pratt, was presented to the court and was duly approved.

The resignation of Dr. W. F. Smith, as County Health Officer, was presented to the court and on motion and second, was duly accepted. Also there came to be considered the application of Dr. E. G. Smith, to be appointed County Health officer, which appointment was granted.

The application of E. R. Carpenter, to be exempt from paying poll tax, was acted on by the court, and said application was granted. It is therefore, the order of the court, that Tax Collector, J. J. Cammack, be authorized to issue to said E. R. Carpenter, an exemption receipt on the grounds of permanent disability.

The said Robert Grace, is therefore granted a Ferry License to operate the aforesaid Ferry for the term of one year from the 15th day of April, A. D. 1930, until the 15 day of April, A. D. 1931.

County of Sabine } Know all men by these presents; that whereas, Robt. Grace, has this day been duly authorized by the Commissioner's court of said County to keep up a ferry for the space of one year next ensuing after the date hereof, at Robertson Crossing, on the Sabine River, in said County and to charge the rates of ferriage established by said court for crossing the same.

Now, therefore, we the said Robt. Grace, as principal, and A. R. Toole, and A. J. Howard as sureties, acknowledge ourselves bound to pay to the County Judge of said County of Sabine, the sum of \$1000.00, conditional that the said above will at all times keep good and sufficient boats for the use of such ferry, and will also keep the banks on each side of the ferry in good repair and so graded and leveled that the raise shall not exceed one foot in every seven feet from the waters edge, to the top of the bank, and that said Ferry Shall be well attended at all times, and that he will comply with all the requirements of the law relating to or governing ferries.
