

Commissioner's Court in and for Sabine County, Texas, met in Special Session, at the regular meeting place thereof, in the courthouse, all members present; to-wit: R. D. Dent, County Judge, W. J. Brown, Commissioner Beat No. 1, J. A. Hyden, Commissioner Beat No. 2, J. D. Edgar, Commissioner Beat No. 3, W. E. Minton, Commissioner Beat No. 4, Mrs. Berta Harper, County Clerk and W. B. Smith, Sheriff, and among other things the following business was had, to-wit: On motion of J. D. Edgar, second by J. A. Hyden, G. W. Burkett was exempted from the payment of a poll tax, on account of permanent disability, which renders him unable to perform manual labor to any normal degree. Motion carried.

A petition by W. E. Clark, and fourteen others, was presented to the court, petition as follows:

To the honorable Commissioner's Court, Sabine County, Texas:

We, the undersigned citizens and tax payers of Sabine County, petition your honorable body to grant us a public road from Highway 87, by the way of N. A. Clark, to Ross Youngblood's place. Signed: N. A. Clark, N. Youngblood, B. B. McNaughten, Ross Youngblood, J. H. Ross, A. B. Bonneau, J. M. Thornton, L. A. Fullen, S. T. Mason, G. B. McNaughten, George B. Clark, J. H. Clark, A. H. Colley, H. W. Low, and W. J. Daniel. Petition granted and said road designated as second class.

It is ordered by the court that the bill of Doctor Sutton and Arnold, for medical care to Arlis Halbert be allowed, the same being in the amount of fifteen dollars (\$15.) and the bill of Doctor C. F. Smith, in the amount of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for hospitalization for Arlis Halbert, be allowed. The County Clerk is authorized to draw script in favor of the respective parties for the above amounts out of the General County fund.

It is also ordered by the court that taxes for 1928, on thirty lots in Brookeland, belonging to John H. Kirby be accepted at the same valuation as placed on the same lots in the year 1929, being \$6. (Six Dollars) per lot. The tax collector is authorized to receive and issue receipts accordingly.

No further business coming up at this time, court adjourned.
