

The Commissioners Court, in and for Sabine County, Texas, met in Regular Session, on the 12th, 1930, with all members present, to-wit: W. H. Dent, County Judge, E. J. Brown, Commissioner, Precinct No. 1, J. D. Edgar, Commr. Precinct No. 3, J. A. Guden, Commr. Precinct No. 2, J. E. Minton, Commissioner Precinct No. 4, Mrs. Berta Harper, County Clerk, and E. P. Smith, Sheriff, and transacted the following business, to-wit:

The returns of a School Trustee election of Plainview Common School District No. 31, was canvassed, by the court, at which election, W. H. Swalt, and Dewey Tatton, were candidates, who had voted at a previous election, and it was found that Dewey Tatton, received 45 votes, and W. H. Swalt received 42 votes. Dewey Tatton, was declared to be elected.

The County Clerk is authorized to issue to C. A. Bell, J. R. Simmons, and Calvin O. Daniel, \$1.00, each for holding said election.

The Bill of Theo. Moffitt, in the amount of \$360.00, for Court House plans and specifications was considered by the court, and rejected, as presented; but the County Clerk, is authorized to issue unto the said Theo. Moffitt, one hundred and twenty dollars, out of the permanent improvement funds, as tender for such service, this being the amount agreed upon by the members of the court, all concurring as being a liberal allowance for said plans and specifications.

On motion duly made and carried, it is ordered by the court that the offer of Kirby Lumber Company, to sell to Sabine County, for the purpose of a County Park, 10 acres, on the John Clark, League's survey, Abstract No. 7, for the consideration of \$1,000.00 same to be issued in two warrants, of \$500.00 each, out of the General County, and Permanent Improvement Fund respectively.

It is further ordered by the court that the said Kirby Lumber Company, be requested to hold said warrants until the 1st day of January 1931, and at which time to use same in the payment of County Advalorum Taxes, the Tax Collector of Sabine County, Texas, is authorized and directed to receive such script for said purpose.

No further business coming up for consideration, at this time court adjourned, and convened on the 13th day of May, as a Board of Equalization, after having taken the required oath and proclamation being made by the sheriff.
