

On this the 29th day of May, The Commissioners Court, sitting as a Board of Equalization after having been in session for fourteen days is adjourned, as a board of equalization, until the 16th day of June, at 9 o'clock A.M. at which time all hearings will be heard by the court of parties who desire to show cause if any they can, why raises, if any, on their values should be imposed on property, rendered by them, for tax purposes, for the year 1931.

The County Clerk, is authorized and directed to give all parties whose values have been raised at least 10 days notice of said raise, and notice of the fact that the Court will reconvene as a board of equalization to hear said reasons if any, of any persons seeking to show cause why their value should not be raised and requesting all parties to appear from the 16th day of June up to and including the 19th day of June, during which time all hearings will be had.

On this the 29th day of May, at 11 o'clock A.M. the Commissioners Court, all members being present having adjourned as a Board of Equalization is immediately convened in Special Session for the transaction of other business, and at which time no business was had except the allowance of accounts for road and bridge purposes and commissioners salaries to date.

Court is adjourned until the regular session on June the 9th, 1930.
