

On this the 14th day of July, 1930, the Commissioner's Court met in regular session, in the regular meeting place, in the court house thereof, all members present, to-wit: H. H. Dent, County Judge; A. J. McGown, Commissioner of precinct No. 1, J. A. Hudson, Commissioner of Precinct No. 2, J. D. Edgar, Commissioner of Precinct No. 3, J. E. Tinton, Commissioner of Precinct No. 4, Mrs. Berta Harper, County Clerk, and E. B. Smith, Sheriff.

The following business was transacted: On motion and second duly carried the order authorizing W. E. Means of Bronson, as Justice of the Peace of that precinct was rescinded on account of W. E. Means being unable to serve and the petition by C. C. Parker and thirty-one (31) others asking that W. W. Garriott be appointed Justice of the Peace, of said precinct was also considered and on motion and second duly carried W. W. Garriott was appointed to fill said vacancy. His bond was also approved.

The monthly report of the County Treasurer was approved. Accounts were allowed:

The order with reference to the Tax Collector's refund to George Morris and Ruford Daniel was rescinded and the County Clerk authorized to issue a writ to each of these persons, against the road district sinking fund of Road District No. 8, in the amount of \$38.00 each, as allowed by a resolution passed at the special session June 23rd, 1930.

It is ordered by the court that \$80.00, against the General County Fund be issued to County Judge, H. H. Dent, to be used to defray the following expenses: For burial of Negro Sawyer near Geneva, in the amount of \$41.00, the balance of the \$39.00 to be used in small amounts for the benefit of a few extreme cases including Mrs. Weeks, of Geneva, Mr. ... of Finland, with allagra, and some for Red Cross, and other purposes.

There being no further business court adjourned.
