Be it remembered that the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas, met in special session at the courthouse of said County, on the 31st day of December, A. D. 1930, present the following members: R. H. Dent, County Judge, Mrs. Berta Harper, County Clerk, E. B. Smith, Sheriff, E. J. McGown, Commissioner of Precinct No. 1, J. A. Hyden, Commissioner of Precinct

No. 2, J. D. Edgar, Commissioner of Precinct No. 3, and J. E. Minton, Commissioner of Precinct No. 4.

Whereas, The First National Bank of Hemphill, has heretofore been the duly qualified and acting Depository for Sabine County, Texas, for the term beginning with the first regular term of this court in February 1929, and ending at the first regular term of this court in February 1931, and

Whereas, said bank, acting as such Depository was on the 18th day of December, A. D. 1930, closed by order of its directors and its affairs placed in the hands of the controller of currency of the United States and is now unable to act as Depository for the County, and

Whereas, the First National Bank, of San Augustine, has offered to act as Depository for Sabine County, without interest until the February Term, of this court in 1931.

Whereupon it is moved, seconded and motion carried by a unanimous vote that the offer of the First National Bank, of San Augustine, Texas, to act as Depository of Sabine County, be accepted.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas, with all its members present and voting that the First National Bank, of San Augustine, Texas, be and is hereby selected and designated as the County Depository Bank, for Sabine County.

It is further ordered that said Bank, be required to furnish a personal bond with five or more good and sufficient sureties in the sum of sixty thousand (\$60,000.00) Dollars to be approved by this court.

It is further ordered that upon the approval of said bond, all officers of Sabine County and those having financial dealings with said County, shall deposit all funds belonging to said County and to the Common Schools of said County in said Depository.

It is further ordered that the bond required of said Depository when duly approved shall be recorded by the County Clerk, of Sabine County, and that the County Clerk, shall forward to the controller of the State of Texas, a copy of this order, and a copy of said Bond duly certified.
