

The Honorable Commissioners' court in and for Sabine County, Texas, met in Regular Session January 12th, 1931, with the following members present, R. H. Dent, County Judge, E. J. McGown, Commissioner of Precinct No. 1, W. R. Low, Commissioner of Precinct No. 2, M. E. McDaniel, Commissioner of Precinct No. 3, and J. E. Minton, Commr. of Precinct No. 4, E. B. Smith, Sheriff, and Mrs. Persa Harper, County Clerk, and transacted the following business, to-wit:

It is ordered by the court that bids be received for the operation of the Ferry at Pendleton, for the next two years, provided that if, a free bridge is constructed during this time, that any contract to operate the ferry will immediately terminate, and be null and void.

It is also ordered by the court that bids be advertised for a County Depository for the next two years. All bids to be received till two o'clock on February 9th, 1931.

It is ordered by the court that the Bond of F. E. Ellison, as Constable of Precinct No. 6, of Sabine County, be approved. And also that the Bond of C. H. Young, as Justice of the Peace, of Precinct No. 6, of Sabine County, be approved.

It is further ordered by the court that due to the fact of the Comptrollers' refusal to approve the bond as County Depository made by the First National Bank, of San Augustine, that the offer of the Peoples State Bank, of Bronson, to act as County Depository be accepted, and

which order appears in full on the minutes of this session. The bond of said Bank is also approved.

It is ordered by the court that Script in the amount of \$ _____, consisting of warrants Nos. _____, held by T. G. Fuller, be cancelled and that warrant in lieu thereof, be issued to T. G. Fuller, out of General County fund, for services rendered by cashing script, this being for the purpose of complying with the Statute, providing that County advalorem taxes may be paid in County script issued as Compensation for services rendered the county.

It is also ordered by the court, that script held by Magnolia Gas Company, consisting of Warrants, Nos. _____, be cancelled and that warrant in lieu thereof be issued to them, for the same service and for the purpose aforesaid that of complying with the law providing payment of County Advalorem taxes with County script issued for services rendered the County.

There being no further business, court adjourned till Tuesday 14th, inst.
